Thank you for downloading the public camping application for our 2026 show, please read carefully all terms and conditions, complete the form and return as advised overleaf.

- Camping pitches are for two adults and three children under 16, in one caravan/ motorhome or tent.
- Any additional adults will be charged for, and no extra pitch space included.
- Single occupancy pitches available, no extra adults can be added to these pitches.
- Pitches are allocated on arrival, if you arrive before your pre-booked time slot, you will be held until the appropriate time.
- Daily admission to the show is included in the camping price.
- Our public campsite opens from Thursday 16th until midday on Monday 20th July 2026.
- There are water points, toilets and Elson disposal points.
- We do not have electric hook-up or shower facilities.
- Dogs are welcome on leads and please clear up after them.
- We have a FREE tractor trailer bus that picks up by the public campsite and can take you around the Rally site, with various bus stops on route.
- As usual we have entertainment on Friday and Saturday evenings, when the fairground, catering units and bars stays open late.

All pitches are subject to acceptance, and allocated on arrival. The rally has the right to refuse entry, or to remove campers from the site.

Public Camping - Site Rules

General

- Park as instructed by camping officials/stewards. If you pitch outside the boundaries of your pitch, or your unit is considered to pose a risk to the safety and comfort of others, you may be asked to move/relocate pitch
- Wristbands are issued on arrival, please wear at all times. These are non-transferable, and there is no refund for lost or unused wristbands. Broken or damaged wristbands will be replaced, only if the damaged wristband is presented at the time of exchange
- No refunds are given for customer cancellations under any circumstance
- We have a 5mph MAX speed limit, there are often children and dogs around and we ask that you pay special attention whilst driving
- Dogs must be kept on leads and you must clear up after them
- Water points, hand washing facility, toilets and Elson points available
- We do not have electric hook-up or shower facilities
- Generators are allowed, we prefer diesel to petrol for safety reasons. They must be turned off between the hours of 23:00 and 08:00
- We would prefer you used composite LPG cylinder and not metal cylinders
- Please keep noise levels so as not to disturb other campers, especially between 23:00 and 08:00
- Bins are provided, please use them and clear all rubbish away from your pitch before leaving

BBQs / Open Fires

- No charcoal BBQs, open fires or fire pits allowed
- Gas BBQs allowed, they must be supervised at all times and not on the floor, they must be on a suitable surface, or own stand
- Depending on the weather/ground situation, all BBQs may be banned

Arrival / Departure

- Arrivals only for what you have booked, if you arrive earlier than times stated on your booking form, you will be put in a holding bay
- Once all arrivals are on site, gates close at 23:00 and reopen at 07:00 (unless for emergencies)
- All campers must vacate the site by 12:00 on Monday 20th July 2026

By signing and submitting this application form you and all persons in your party are agreeing and accepting these Terms and Conditions. You agree to be responsible for any loss, damage or injury caused by any members of your party and for their behaviour whilst on site. Any unsocial or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in the person or the whole party being removed, without refunds given.
